These boxes go to countries around the world, and are filled with toys and hygiene items, as well as a Christmas card of blessing. This is a mission outreach our kids really enjoy, since they can understand personally how they are helping another child. For this event, we are in need of donations, including small arts and crafts items, small toys (like matchbox cars and



bouncy balls), jacks, jump ropes, small stuffed animals and dolls, combs and brushes, hats and gloves, hair accessories, coloring books and small children's books, hard candy (no chocolate), and anything a child of nursery age to teenage years would enjoy. And don't forget, it has to fit in a shoebox!

So, as we prepare for Thanksgiving this year, let us pause to remember all the ways our Lord blesses us and think of how we might share His blessings with others.
