SCRIPTURE READING

1 Samuel 3:1-10

- 3 The boy Samuel ministered before the LORD under Eli. In those days the word of the LORD was rare; there were not many visions.
- ²One night Eli, whose eyes were becoming so weak that he could barely see, was lying down in his usual place.
- ³ The lamp of God had not yet gone out, and Samuel was lying down in the house of the LORD, where the ark of God was.
- ⁴ Then the LORD called Samuel. Samuel answered, "Here I am."
- ⁵ And he ran to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me." But Eli said, "I did not call; go back and lie down." So he went and lay down.
- ⁶ Again the LORD called, "Samuel!" And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me." "My son," Eli said, "I did not call; go back and lie down."
- ⁷ Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD: The word of the LORD had not yet been revealed to him.
- ⁸ A third time the LORD called, "Samuel!" And Samuel got up and went to Eli and said, "Here I am; you called me." Then Eli realized that the LORD was calling the boy.
- ⁹ So Eli told Samuel, "Go and lie down, and if he calls you, say, 'Speak, LORD, for your servant is listening." So Samuel went and lay down in his place.
- ¹⁰ The LORD came and stood there, calling as at the other times, "Samuel! Samuel!"

Then Samuel said, "Speak, for your servant is listening."

<u>Psalm 139:1-18, 23-24</u> (read responsively)

- 1 O Lord, you have searched me and known me!
- 2 You know when I sit down and when I rise up; you discern my thoughts from afar.
- 3 You search out my path and my lying down, and are acquainted with all my ways.
- 4 Even before a word is on my tongue, O Lord, you know it altogether.
- 5 You pursue me, behind and before, and lay your hand upon me.
- 6 Such knowledge is too wonderful for me; it is high, I cannot attain it.
- <u>7</u> Whither shall I go from your spirit? Or whither shall I flee from your presence?
- 8 If I ascend to heaven, you are there! If I make my bed in Sheol, you are there!
- g If I take the wings of the morning and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea,
- 10 even there your hand shall lead me, and your right hand shall hold me.
- 11 If I say, "Let only darkness cover me, and the light about me be night,"
- 12 even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is bright as the day; for darkness is as light with you.
- 13 For it was you who formed my inward parts, you knit me together in my mother's womb.
- 14 I praise you, for you are fearful and wonderful. Wonderful are your works! You know me very well;
- 15 My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately wrought in the depths of the earth.
- 16 Your eyes beheld my unformed substance; in your book were written the days that were formed for me, every day, before they came into being.
- 17 How profound to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them!
- 18 If I would count them, they are more than the sand. When I awake, I am still with you.

- 23 Search me, O God, and know my heart! Try me and know my thoughts;
- 24 and see if there be any wicked way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting!

- ⁴³ The next day Jesus decided to leave for Galilee. Finding Philip, he said to him, "Follow me."
- ⁴⁴ Philip, like Andrew and Peter, was from the town of Bethsaida.
- ⁴⁵ Philip found Nathanael and told him, "We have found the one Moses wrote about in the Law, and about whom the prophets also wrote—Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph."
- ⁴⁶ "Nazareth! Can anything good come from there?" Nathanael asked.
- "Come and see," said Philip.
- ⁴⁷ When Jesus saw Nathanael approaching, he said of him, "Here truly is an Israelite in whom there is no deceit."
- ⁴⁸ "How do you know me?" Nathanael asked. Jesus answered, "I saw you while you were still under the fig tree before Philip called you."
- ⁴⁹ Then Nathanael declared, "Rabbi, you are the Son of God; you are the king of Israel."
- ⁵⁰ Jesus said, "You believe because I told you I saw you under the fig tree. You will see greater things than that."
- ⁵¹ He then added, "Very truly I tell you, you will see 'heaven open, and the angels of God ascending and descending on the Son of Man.
