# **OPENING PRAYER:**

# Zechariah 9:9-12 (NIV)

- <sup>9</sup> Rejoice greatly, Daughter Zion! Shout, Daughter Jerusalem! See, your king comes to you, righteous and victorious, lowly and riding on a donkey, on a colt, the foal of a donkey.
- <sup>10</sup> I will take away the chariots from Ephraim and the warhorses from Jerusalem, and the battle bow will be broken. He will proclaim peace to the nations. His rule will extend from sea to sea and from the River to the ends of the earth.
- <sup>11</sup> As for you, because of the blood of my covenant with you, I will free your prisoners from the waterless pit
- <sup>12</sup> Return to your fortress, you prisoners of hope; even now I announce that I will restore twice as much to you.

# **PSALM 118:1-2, 19-29** (NIV)

- <sup>1</sup> Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever.
- <sup>2</sup>Let Israel say: "His love endures forever."
- <sup>19</sup> Open for me the gates of the righteous; I will enter and give thanks to the LORD.
- <sup>20</sup> This is the gate of the LORD through which the righteous may enter.
- <sup>21</sup> I will give you thanks, for you answered me; you have become my salvation.
- <sup>22</sup> The stone the builders rejected has become the cornerstone;
- <sup>23</sup> the LORD has done this, and it is marvelous in our eyes.
- <sup>24</sup> The LORD has done it this very day; let us rejoice today and be glad.
- <sup>25</sup> LORD, save us! LORD, grant us success!

#### **GOSPEL READING**

# **Mark 11:1-11** (NIV)

Jesus sent two of his disciples, <sup>2</sup> saying to them, "Go to the village ahead of you, and just as you enter it, you will find a colt tied there, which no one has ever ridden. Untie it and bring it here.

- <sup>3</sup> If anyone asks you, 'Why are you doing this?' say, 'The Lord needs it and will send it back here shortly.'" As they approached Jerusalem and came to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives,
- <sup>4</sup> They went and found a colt outside in the street, tied at a doorway. As they untied it,
- <sup>5</sup> some people standing there asked, "What are you doing, untying that colt?"
- <sup>6</sup> They answered as Jesus had told them to, and the people let them go.
- <sup>7</sup> When they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their cloaks over it, he sat on it.
- <sup>8</sup> Many people spread their cloaks on the road, while others spread branches they had cut in the fields.
- <sup>9</sup> Those who went ahead and those who followed shouted, "Hosanna! "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!"
- <sup>10</sup> "Blessed is the coming kingdom of our father David! "Hosanna in the highest heaven!"
- <sup>11</sup> Jesus entered Jerusalem and went into the temple courts. He looked around at everything, but since it was already late, he went out to Bethany with the Twelve.
