

Happy New Year UMCSO Family!

As we enter into 2026, are you pondering the future? Concerns about finances, family, health, broken relationships and other matters threaten to embitter us. The message of Christmas reminds us that, although we do not have control over the details of our lives, Jesus is with us on our journey. It is also a time to set New Year's Resolutions. In Colossians 3:15-17 Paul gives us great Resolutions as we enter into 2026.



<sup>15</sup> Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. <sup>16</sup> Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. <sup>17</sup> And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

In the spirit of resolution, listen to Paul's guidance to the Colossians: **let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts.** In our recovery from the stress of the season, and in light of family dynamics that are sometimes less than ideal, we hear this gentle word of wisdom. We humbly acknowledge that Jesus Christ, whose birth we have celebrated, is the Lord of all things.

**Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly.** Sometimes we begin a new year with grand intentions to read the entire Bible, from cover to cover.

Then, in early January we crash and burn somewhere in Leviticus!

Instead, we need to allow the word of Christ—some parable, some teaching, some fragment of good news—to dwell in us.

We should also sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs to God.

Carols help us to offer praise to God for the miracle of new birth and new life.

Finally, **we are to do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus.**

As we begin a new year, in both civic and church calendars, we aspire to live as Jesus lives; to be his presence in the world. The incarnation, God taking human form, becomes a reality as we live in peace, as the scripture dwells in us and changes us, as we offer praise, as we follow the One who is the word made flesh, full of grace and truth.

**This is the very best resolution of them all!**

Trust Him, imitate Him, and love Him. Know that there is real power for transformation for those He calls his own and He will indeed make all things well. Jesus walks with us through the highs and lows of life and for this we may be grateful eternally. God wants His people to prosper and flourish. God is with us and will stand with us not only to simply get us through this next year but will help us overcome with abundance!!
